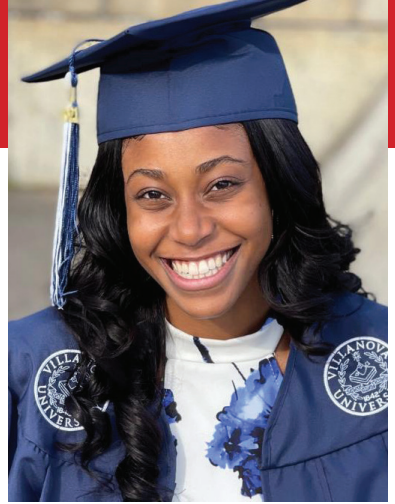


Amira Martin
