She has a long history of volunteering with the Linda Creed Breast Cancer organization, an organization that supports women who have been diagnosed with cancer, and raise funds to help support and encourage women to get annual mammograms for early detection. She has been volunteering her services since 9th grade by helping with filing, logging and fund-raising activities. She holds this organization dear.
